

LANDMARK 20TH SEASON OF WARM UP BEGINS JULY 1

TICKETS ON SALE NOW FOR ALL EVENTS IN 2017 INCLUDING LIMITED \$98 PACKAGE FOR ALL TEN DATES

LONG ISLAND CITY, New York, March 21, 2017—MoMA PS1's pioneering outdoor music series Warm Up celebrates its 20th season in 2017, with ten Saturdays presenting the best in live and electronic music—both local and global—across a range of genres. Warm Up 2017 begins on Saturday, July 1 and runs through Saturday, September 2, featuring a to-be-announced lineup of emerging and established artists as part of an ambitious and wide-ranging program.

Advance tickets are now available for all Warm Up 2017 dates. In celebration of Warm Up's founding year, MoMA PS1 will offer a special "1998" ticket package providing access to all ten dates for only \$98, available for a limited time only. Full ticketing information follows below.

Over its 20 seasons, Warm Up has featured more than 750 artists, including pop artists Solange, Jamie XX, and Grimes, experimental musicians Arca, Black Dice, and Four Tet, and legendary DJs like DJ Premier, Ritchie Hawtin, and Derrick May. One of the longest-running music programs within a museum, Warm Up has a history of supporting seminal artists before they come to prominence and providing a platform for experimentation, unique collaborations, and new material.

An integral part of MoMA PS1's contemporary program, Warm Up provides an opportunity for audiences to engage with today's most experimental and innovative artists across media. Warm Up takes place within a site-specific installation by the winners of the annual Young Architects Program and striking stage environments by cutting-edge designers that complement each week's program. For summer 2017, MoMA PS1's courtyard will feature an immersive installation by Jenny Sabin Studio made of photoluminescent textiles that transform over the course of a day. Audiences are encouraged to visit the exhibition galleries and experience MoMA PS1's diverse program of emerging artists, new genres, and adventurous work by recognized artists.

Warm Up 2017 is organized by a dynamic curatorial committee led by Eliza Ryan and Imogene Strauss, featuring new members Mattis With (Young Turks), Venus X (GHE20G0TH1K), and Naomi Zeichner (*The FADER*), alongside returning curators Dean Bein (True Panther Sounds) and Matt Werth (RVNG Intl.), with Taja Cheek, Curatorial Assistant, MoMA PS1 and Rosey Selig-Addiss, Associate Producer, MoMA PS1.

On Sunday March 26, Warm Up curators Eliza Ryan and Imogene Strauss will interview MoMA PS1 Director Klaus Biesenbach about the history of Warm Up along with special guests, broadcast live on Know Wave Radio from MoMA PS1's Come Together: Music Festival and Label Market.

Directions: MoMA PS1 is located at 22-25 Jackson Avenue at 46th Ave in Long Island City, Queens, across the Queensboro Bridge from midtown Manhattan and is easily accessible by bus and subway. Traveling by subway, take either the E or M to Court Square-23 Street; the 7 to 45 Road-Courthouse Square; or the G to Court Sq or 21 St-Van Alst. By bus, take the Q67 to Jackson and 46th Ave or the B62 to 46th Ave.

MoMA PS1 Background: MoMA PS1 is one of the largest and oldest organizations in the United States devoted to contemporary art. Established in 1976 by Alanna Heiss, MoMA PS1 originated from The Institute for Art and Urban Resources, a not-for-profit organization founded five years prior with the mission of turning abandoned, underutilized buildings in New York City into artist studios and exhibition spaces. P.S.1 Contemporary Art Center, as it then was known, became an affiliate of The Museum of Modern Art in 2000.
