WARM UP 2018 TAKES PLACE JUNE 30 TO SEPTEMBER 1

Ticket Package for All Ten Dates Now Available for a Limited Time Only

LONG ISLAND CITY, NY, **March 26, 2018** – MoMA PS1's pioneering outdoor music series Warm Up returns in 2018 with ten Saturdays presenting the best in live and electronic music. Acclaimed for its ambitious program, Warm Up celebrates a wide range of artists: emerging and established, local and global, and across genres. Warm Up 2018 runs from Saturday, June 30 through Saturday, September 1, with the full lineup announced in May.

MoMA PS1 has launched a special ticket package offering admission and expedited entry for all ten dates, available for \$99 for a limited time only at mo.ma/ticketpackage.

Warm Up 2018 is organized by a dynamic curatorial committee led by Eliza Ryan and Naomi Zeichner (YouTube) with Taja Cheek (MoMA PS1), featuring new members Jonas Leon (Leon Institute) and Isabelia Herrera (Remezcla) alongside returning curators Dean Bein (True Panther Sounds), Venus X (GHE20G0TH1K), and Matt Werth (RVNG Intl.).

Now in its 21st season, Warm Up is one of the longest running music programs housed within a museum. As an integral part of MoMA PS1's curatorial program, Warm Up seeks to elevate innovative underrepresented voices and connect fans with music's most important artists. The program's alumni include contemporary creators Solange, Black Dice, Cardi B, Jamie XX, and Arca, as well as legendary DJs including Ritchie Hawtin, DJ Premier, and Derrick May.

Each year, Warm Up takes place within a site-specific installation by the winners of the annual Young Architects Program. For summer 2018, MoMA PS1's courtyard will be transformed by Dream The Combine, a Minneapolis-based team whose design features large-scale mirrors that create unexpected visual connections. Warm Up attendees are encouraged to visit the museum galleries and experience MoMA PS1's acclaimed exhibitions of emerging artists, new genres, and adventurous work by recognized artists.

ABOUT MoMA PS1

MoMA PS1 is devoted to today's most experimental, thought-provoking contemporary art. Founded in 1976 as the P.S.1 Contemporary Art Center, it was the first nonprofit arts center in the United States devoted solely to contemporary art and is recognized as a defining force in the alternative space movement. In 2000 The Museum of Modern Art and P.S.1 Contemporary Art Center merged, creating the largest platform for contemporary art in the



country and one of the largest in the world. Functioning as a living, active meeting place for the general public, MoMA PS1 is a catalyst for ideas, discourses, and new trends in contemporary art.

Hours: MoMA PS1 is open from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Thursday through Monday. Closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day.

Admission: \$10 suggested donation; \$5 for students and senior citizens; free for New York City residents, MoMA members, and MoMA admission ticket holders within 14 days of visit. Free admission as a Gift to New Yorkers made possible by the Anna-Maria and Stephen Kellen Foundation.

Directions: MoMA PS1 is located at 22-25 Jackson Avenue at 46th Ave in Long Island City, Queens, across the Queensboro Bridge from midtown Manhattan. Traveling by subway, take the E, M, or 7 to Court Sq; or the G to Court Sq or 21 St-Van Alst. By bus, take the Q67 to Jackson and 46th Ave or the B62 to 46th Ave.
