WARM UP 2019 CONTINUES WITH RON TRENT, CHANNEL TRES, CHAOS IN THE CBD, SHO MADJOZI, THE MARTINEZ BROTHERS, ANNIE MAC, AND MANY MORE

LONG ISLAND CITY, New York, August 9, 2019— MoMA PS1's pioneering outdoor music series Warm Up continues with four more dates in August, presenting the best in live and electronic music every Saturday through Labor Day weekend. Known for its innovative and ambitious program, Warm Up celebrates a wide range of artists across genres: both emerging and established, local and global. Highlights of the final month of Warm Up include Ron Trent, Eris Drew, Channel Tres, Sho Madjozi, Chaos in the CBD, MIKE, Tygapaw, The Martinez Brothers, FLOORPLAN, Palms Trax, and a final day headlining set by legendary BBC DJ Annie Mac. The full lineup follows below.

Now in its 22nd season, Warm Up is one of the longest running music programs housed within a museum. As an integral part of MoMA PS1's curatorial program, Warm Up seeks to elevate innovative, underrepresented voices and connect fans with music's most important artists. The program's alumni include contemporary creators Solange, Black Dice, Cardi B, Jamie XX, Lizzo, Skepta, Thom Yorke, Four Tet, and A-Trak as well as legendary DJs including Derrick May, DJ Premier, and Ritchie Hawtin.

Each year, Warm Up takes place within a site-specific installation by the winners of the Young Architects Program. This year's winner, *Hórama Rama* by Mexico City-based architects Pedro & Juana, is a 40-foot-tall cyclorama featuring jungle imagery that sits atop the courtyard walls, providing a refuge amid the changing Long Island City skyline. Warm Up attendees are also encouraged to visit the museum galleries and experience MoMA PS1's acclaimed exhibitions of contemporary art from around the world.

Warm Up 2019 will also feature rotating stage environments by design talent including WIFE, COVL, and Emma Kohlmann.

This year, MoMA PS1 is partnering with The Lot Radio for a special Warm Up-focused series airing on Thursdays from 12 to 2 p.m., featuring DJ sets from Warm Up curators, past and future performers, and friends of the program.

Warm Up 2019 is organized by a curatorial committee led by Taja Cheek, Assistant Curator, MoMA PS1, with Eliza Ryan, Naomi Zeichner (YouTube), Dean Bein (True Panther Records), Isabelia Herrera, Jonas Leon (On-Retainer Agency), and Matt Werth (RVNG Intl.).

MoMA PS1 is devoted to today's most experimental, thought-provoking contemporary art. Founded in 1976 as the P.S.1 Contemporary Art Center, it was the first nonprofit arts center in the United States devoted solely to contemporary art and is recognized as a defining force in the alternative space movement. In 2000 The Museum of Modern Art and P.S.1 Contemporary Art Center merged, creating the largest platform for contemporary art in the country and one of the largest in the world. Functioning as a living, active meeting place for the general public, MoMA PS1 is a catalyst for ideas, discourses, and new trends in contemporary art.

**Hours**: MoMA PS1 is open from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Thursday through Monday. Closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day.

**Admission**: \$10 suggested donation; \$5 for students and senior citizens; free for New York City residents, MoMA members, and MoMA admission ticket holders within 14 days of visit. Free admission as a Gift to New Yorkers made possible by the Anna-Maria and Stephen Kellen Foundation.
